

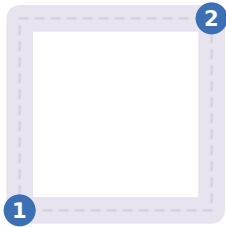

HOW TO RUN IT

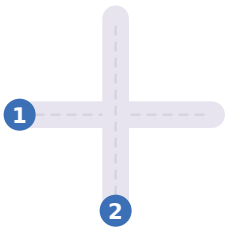
Trace the numbered model using the marked stroke order and direction. Then cover the numbers and reproduce the form three times in the blank boxes, keeping the same order.

1 · Stroke order — follow the numbers, then repeat with the numbers covered



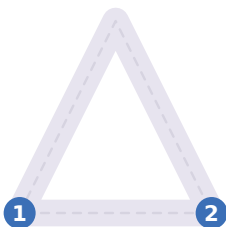
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2 · Stroke order — follow the numbers, then repeat with the numbers covered
